



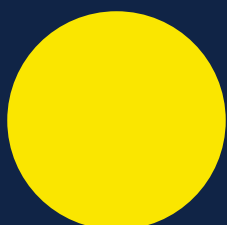

Exceptional Academic Results and Other Recognitions

In the 2023-2024 academic year, 100% of our Baccalaureate students passed the EVAU, achieving an average score of 8.10 out of 10. Additionally, 58.06% obtained a score higher than 10/14, 35.48% exceeded 12/14, and 16.13% achieved more than 13/14, with the highest score being 13.73/14.

Internacional Aravaca has been recognized for the third consecutive year in the educational rankings of Mi Cole, Forbes, El Español, and El Confidencial as one of the top 10 schools in Spain and the Community of Madrid.



Improvements in the Curriculum

We have completed the process that allows us to fully implement the international IB curriculum, becoming one of the 13 schools in the entire Community of Madrid to offer all IB programs: PYP-MYP-DP.

Learning Visits and Improvement Process

Over 300 real-time evidences: Through learning visits, teachers observe their colleagues' classrooms to analyze how students are learning, what type of learning they are developing, and the phase most of them are in during the lesson. The aim is to set improvement objectives for learning. Our Learning Improvement Plan (LIP), based on 9 indicators, has been evaluated with a score of 81.5 out of 100, based on evidence like this.



Expanding the Educational Experience

For the second year, we continue to work on the Emotional Education Program to ensure a positive environment and good coexistence at the school.

We have organized new cultural trips that also help promote unity, with high student participation and satisfaction.

We have expanded the opportunities for international learning through ISP and increased the extracurricular activities offered in line with student suggestions.



Commitment to Talent

Extensive professional training for staff, including courses on methodologies for diversity management, cybersecurity, safeguarding, and the International program.

Improvements in staff salaries and benefits to attract and retain the best talent.



Improvements in Facilities

We have expanded the learning spaces (200 m²) as well as the terraces and playgrounds (200 m²), equipping them with current technology and resources to create environments that promote both academic and social learning. We have also upgraded and renewed the school's equipment, with 8 new digital screens and new playground games.

We have added new recycling points to encourage sustainable habits. Additionally, we have expanded the Sensory Classroom with new specialized materials to enrich the students' experiences.



Student Safety

We have reinforced the safeguarding of our students by implementing new control processes for school outings, including identification wristbands and a thorough risk assessment.

We have also established a new management system for the use of iPads both in classrooms and at home, aimed at promoting responsible use, and we have made an investment in infrastructure to ensure their efficient management.



EcoSchool

We have received the Green Flag from the Eco-Schools program, which recognizes the methodology we use to focus on environmental respect and care, in addition to the curricular subject in Primary.



Ongoing Focus on Socio-Emotional Skills

We have implemented the MindUP program in Early Childhood to help students regulate their emotions, improve concentration, and develop socio-emotional skills through mindfulness and positive thinking. The program will expand across the grade levels.



Commitment to Parental Involvement

We encourage family involvement in the daily life of the school through various programs, such as Café con Marta, a space to share opinions and suggestions about our management; the Open Day of the Cafeteria, where families can come and sample the school meals; and the Open Day In-Person, which allows them to visit classrooms and interact with other families at a special event, among other initiatives.

Additionally, we send satisfaction surveys for each activity, as well as for the overall management of the school, for our quarterly Net Promoter Score (NPS).

We are currently engaged in the process of obtaining a new international accreditation from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC), which helps develop and maintain sustainable academic programs, ensuring high standards of quality and effectiveness.

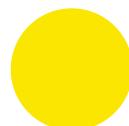


In 2026, we will have the evaluation visit for the PYP program after five years of implementation, as well as the biennial internal ISP evaluation of our students' learning.

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University Admissions

A significant number of our students from the 2023-2024 cohort have been admitted to the university programs they sought, including Medicine, Dentistry, Psychology, Veterinary Medicine, Business Administration, Protocol and Event Management, Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence, Aerospace Engineering, Mathematical Engineering and Artificial Intelligence, Industrial Technology Engineering, Computer Engineering, and Business and Technology. These students have been accepted into prestigious universities such as the Complutense University of Madrid, ICAI and ICADE at the Pontifical University of Comillas, Alfonso X El Sabio University, the Polytechnic University of Madrid, Carlos III University of Madrid, and IE University.

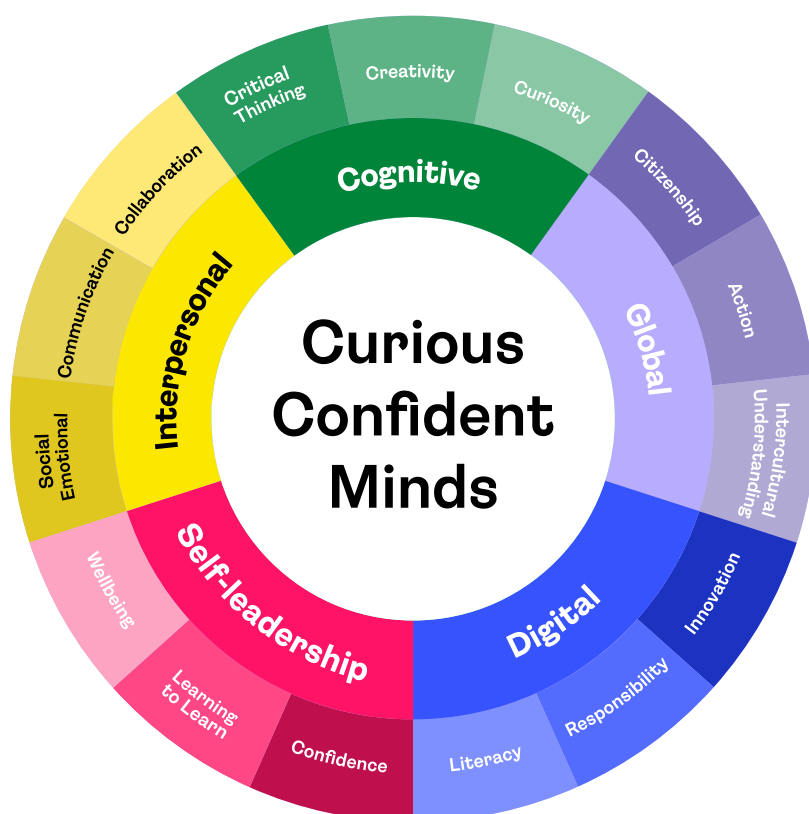

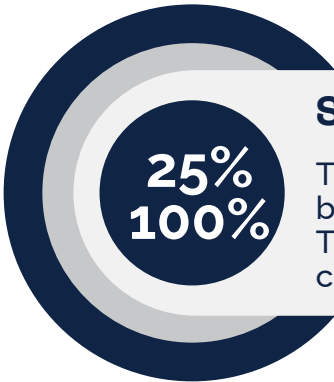

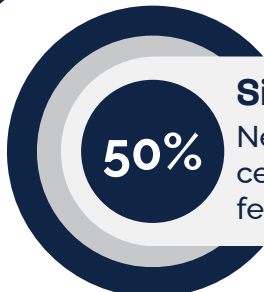

Sibling discount

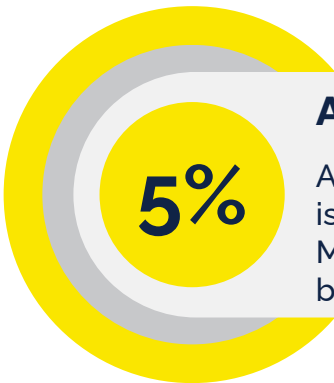
The **third sibling** will have a **25% discount** on tuition and place booking.

A **5% discount** on the tuition fee will be applied if the full year's fee is paid in advance. To do so, please apply before 30 June 2025 to Marta García - m.garcia@ia.edu.es, and payment must be made before 31 July 2025.



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Payment Options for Tuition Fee



MONTHLY

10 monthly installments from September to June, paid on the 1st of each month.



ANNUAL

A single payment made before July 31, 2025.
A 5% discount will be applied.

Glossary

- **Registration for new students** – The Enrollment fee is a one-time, non-refundable payment made for the admission of a new student, once the student has been accepted into the school.
- **Enrolment Fee for new students and Re-enrolment Fee for existing students** – The Enrolment or Re-enrolment Fee is a non-refundable amount that is part of the annual tuition cost. **Its purpose is to establish the student's commitment for the planning and organization of the next school year.**
- **Tuition Fees** – This amount covers the student's teaching costs. It can be paid monthly (10 months) or annually (1 payment).

Conditions



- **The school fees include:**
 - IB International Program at all stages.
 - Continuity of studies insurance and accident insurance for students.
 - EVAU and International Baccalaureate exam fees. Baccalaureate Diploma.
 - Curricular field trips.
 - School supplies (backpack, notebooks, pencils, etc.).
 - Swimming pool from Early Childhood 2 to Primary 2, both included.
 - Preparation for official Cambridge, DELF, and Goethe exams.
 - Psychopedagogical counseling service and comprehensive development support. University guidance.
 - Nursing service and health program.
 - Technological support for devices.
 - International programs (ILOS) (excluding related trips).
 - Eco-school programs, early stimulation, and school coexistence.
- **The school fees do not include:**
 - Books, uniforms, or iPads.
 - Fees for official exams not specified above.
 - Optional trips.
- The cafeteria and transportation fees will be prorated based on the number of days the student attends school during the year.
- The school reserves the right to expel or cancel a student's place for the next academic year if there are any outstanding payments for school fees.
- Withdrawal during the academic year must be notified with two months' notice; otherwise, a penalty of one month's tuition will be applied, as outlined in the parents' contract.
- Failure to pay more than one installment issued by the school will prevent participation in trips and extracurricular activities.
- In the case of continued non-payment without a valid reason, the school reserves the right to apply a 3% surcharge on the amount owed.
- Additionally, it is mandatory for all students to be up to date with their payments by the end of the school year to reserve their place and continue the following academic year.
- Returned direct debit payments will incur a €10 charge.
- School fees will be reviewed annually.

Conditions

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- The place will be reserved upon payment of the reservation and enrollment fees. This payment is non-refundable.
- If the student does not ultimately enroll in the reserved course, none of these fees will be refunded.
- For the following year, if you do not wish to renew the student's place, you must submit the Withdrawal Form to Valle Ramos (v.ramos@ia.edu.es) before the deadline set by the school. A minimum notice period of 60 days is required to avoid penalties, as stated in the Parent Contract.
- If the student does not ultimately enroll in the reserved course, none of these fees will be refunded.
