





Exceptional Academic Results

In the 2024-2025 academic year, 100% of our sixth form students passed the EVAU, obtaining an average mark of 7.8 out of 10. In addition, 35.29% achieved a grade higher than 10/14, 23.5% exceeded 12/14 and 6% achieved more than 13/14, with a maximum grade of 13.66/14.

Looking to the Future...

External evaluations are key to our continuous improvement.



- This year we are undergoing the IB PYP evaluation, a rigorous and transparent process that analyses how we teach and how our students learn from an external and specialised perspective.
- Complementing this, we have the ISP group evaluation, which systematically reviews student learning and our teaching practices.

These assessments enable us to identify strengths and continue improving an educational approach focused on developing skills, critical thinking and decision-making, preparing our students to face their academic and professional future with confidence.

A 5% discount on the tuition fee will apply if the full academic year is paid in advance. To qualify, families must request this option before 30 June 2026 by contacting Marta García at m.garcia@ia.edu.es and payment must be completed before 31 July 2026.

Glossary

- **Enrolment fee for new students** - The enrolment fee is a one-off, non-refundable payment charged upon admission of a new student, once the student has been formally accepted by the school.
- **Annual Tuition** - Annual Tuition is the total of the Advance Payment (paid in 3 instalments: March, April and May) plus the full amount of the 10 Monthly Tuition instalments.
- **Advance payment for new and existing students** - The advance payment is a non-refundable amount that is part of the annual tuition cost and secures the student's place. Its purpose is to establish a commitment from the family to support planning and organisation for the following academic year.
- **Monthly Tuition** - This is the amount of the Annual Tuition minus the Advance Payment that secures the place, divided into 10 instalments from September to June. If these 10 instalments are paid in a single payment, a 5% discount will apply.

Conditions



- **School fees include:**
 - IB International Programme at all stages
 - Continuity of studies insurance
 - Accident insurance for students
 - EVAU and IB Diploma Programme exam fees
 - Curricular excursions
 - School supplies (backpack, notebooks, pencils, etc.)
 - Swimming pool from Infant 2 to Primary 2, both included
 - Preparation for official Cambridge, DELF and Goethe exams
 - Psycho-pedagogical counselling service and comprehensive development support University guidance
 - Nursing service and health programme
 - Technical support for devices
 - International programmes (ILOS) (excluding related trips)
 - Eco-school, emotional wellbeing, early stimulation and school coexistence programmes
- **School fees do not include:**
 - Books, uniforms, or iPads
 - Official examination fees not specified above
 - Voluntary trips
- Lunch and transport fees will be prorated based on the number of days the student attends school during the year.
- The school reserves the right to expel or cancel a student's place for the next academic year in the event of outstanding school fee payments.
- Withdrawal during the school year must be notified with two months' notice, otherwise a penalty of one month's tuition will be applied, as indicated in the parents' **contract**.
- Failure to pay more than one monthly fee issued by the school will prevent participation in trips and special activities.
- In the event of continued non-payment without just cause, the school reserves the right to apply a 3% surcharge on the amount owed.
- Likewise, all students must be up to date with their payments at the end of the school year in order to reserve their place and continue the following school year.
- Returned direct debit payments will incur a charge of €10.
- School fees will be reviewed annually.
